All professional excavators, homeowners, facility operators, and contract locators, who excavate and/or operate throughout the state of Minnesota.

WHERE

The entire state of Minnesota

WHY

Damage prevention and worker safety

WHEN

August 1, 2024
(except geospatial mapping requirement per 216D.04 Subd. 3 (h) – January 1, 2026 OR 2027)

- Electronic white marking transition period: 216D.05 (b) clause 2
- Electronic white marking used prior to January 1, 2026, is accompanied by equivalent physical markings
